1. Sheidley Waterline Replacement Project- Award Bid

Public Works staff initiated a 2021 budget item for replacement of a section of 8" waterline on Sheidley Avenue just north of the intersection with Glenwood Avenue.

This area is in extremely rocky terrain and the current line has experienced multiple failures and service interruptions. This project is intended to replace this section of waterline which is approximately 600 feet in length.

Public bids were solicited and seven bid responses were received. The lowest and best bid has been determined to be from Linaweaver Construction, Inc.

Action Make a motion to approve the bid from Linaweaver Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$115,832 for the construction related to the Sheidley Waterline Replacement Project.
