Bonner Springs Curbside Recycling Program

When: Waste Management picks up recycle bins on the same day as regular trash pickup.

How: Residents must have a bin labeled “Recycle” to set out at the curb on the regular trash day.

Who: All single family homes, duplexes and four-plexes that receive residential trash service from Waste Management (except Lake Forest & mobile home park residents) will have curbside recycling services. This is not for apartments or businesses.

What: Place items in, or adjacent to, your recycle bin and place at the curb each week on your regular trash day.

ITEMS THAT WILL BE PICKED UP:

Paper: newspapers (include inserts and ads), office paper, junk mail, magazines and catalogues.

Paperboard: Paperboard is the material used to make cereal, cracker, beverage and shoe boxes. Breakdown your paperboard and place them in a paper grocery bag along with your paper.

Plastic #1 through #7: Please rinse all bottles and containers, remove lids or caps and throw lids and caps into garbage, unless marked with the appropriate number.

Aluminum & Steel Cans: Rinse out and crush prior to putting them into your bin.

Corrugated Cardboard: Corrugated cardboard refers to shipping boxes that have the “wavy middle layer”. Boxes should be flattened and cut to pieces of 2 feet by 2 feet and tied together.

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

- glass
- plastic bags
- shredded paper
- pizza boxes
- books
- styrofoam
- disposable diapers
- egg cartons
- automotive product bottles
- lawn chemical bottles
- plastic sheet material.

NOTE: If the bin set out for pickup contains these prohibited items, it will not be picked up.

Recycle & Yard Waste Disposal Locations for Residents & Businesses

Weekly Trash Pick Up Day - Tuesday 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. except holidays designated by Waste Management. If the holiday is on or before your normal pick-up day, trash and recycle items will be picked up one day later that week. Set out at the curb on trash day. Leaves and grass must be bagged to not exceed 50 pounds. Tree limbs must be bundled in sections not to exceed 4 feet in length or 50 pounds.

Waste Management Recycle Center - 17955 Holiday Drive, Shawnee - Saturday and Sunday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Aluminum cans, batteries, newspaper, steel cans, plastic bottles, cardboard, office paper, magazines and car motor oil. Visit wastemanagement.com.

Waste Management Landfill Johnson County on Holliday Drive -7 Days per Week 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. - Residents can dispose of grass, leaves, garden waste, leaves or branches. Will not accept stumps or logs in excess of 4 inches in diameter or over four feet in length.
