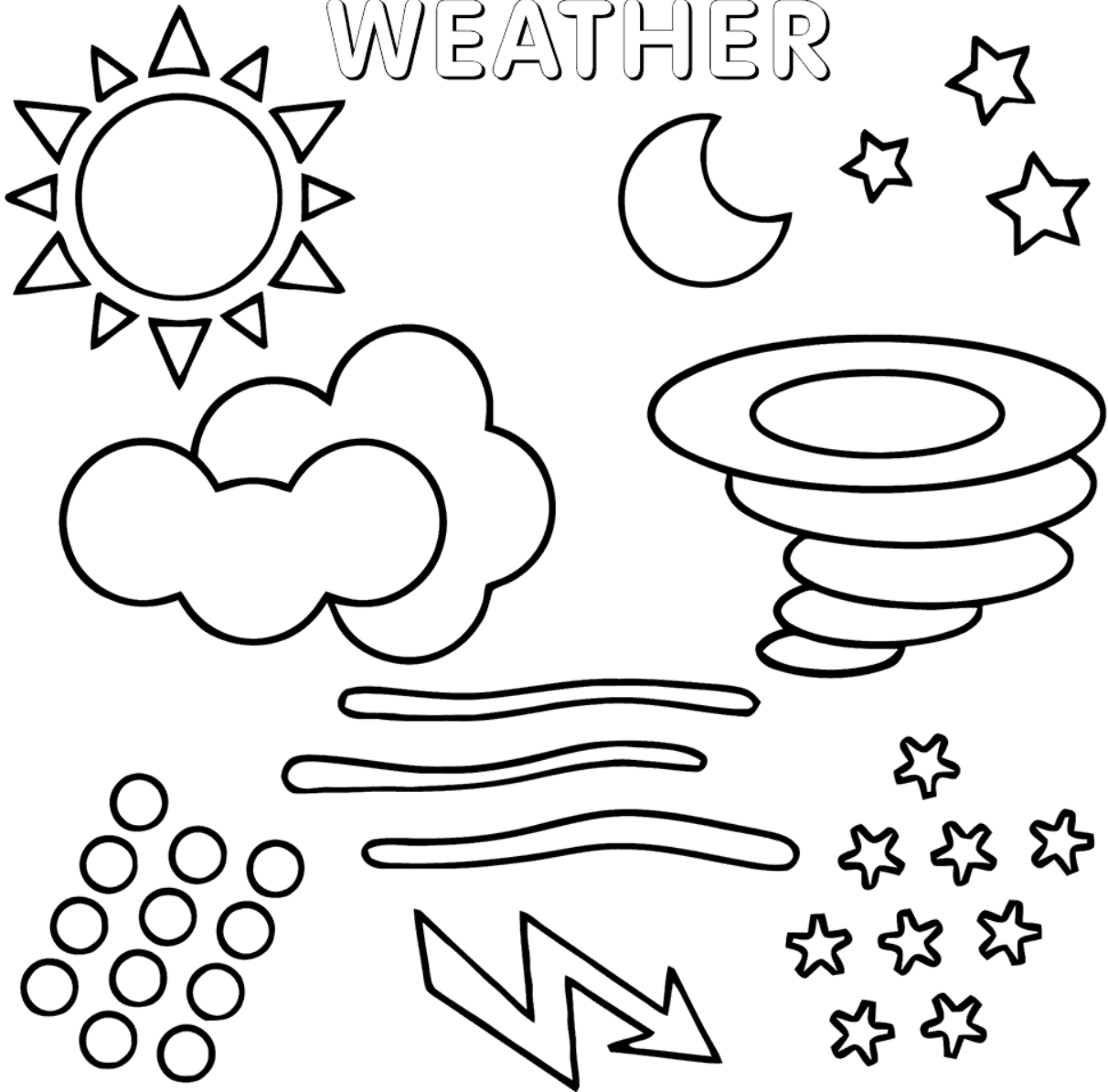

Day 1: Coloring Sheets

Day 1: Craft- Umbrella and Rain

What you will need:

- Piece of paper
- Markers
- Blue Water Paint with brush or cotton swab

Directions:

1. Draw an umbrella and color inside of it. Add a handle to the bottom of the umbrella.
2. Once colored, add rain drops with the blue water paint. You can use either a brush or cotton swab to make the rain drops.

Day 1: Flash Game- Snowball Fight: Weather Edition

What you will need:

- 3 pieces of paper
- Writing Utensil
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Cut the piece of paper into $\frac{1}{4}$ pieces equaling a total of 12 pieces of paper.
2. On each piece of paper, write down the following:

Jump in a Puddle	Twirl like a Tornado	Blow like the Wind
Shake like Thunder	Make a Snow Angel	Gently Fall like the Rain
Freeze like Ice	Curve like a Rainbow	Rise like the Temperature
Drop like the Temperature	Float like Fog	Shine Bright like the Sun

3. Once you have written down all the activities, crumble them up into snowballs.
4. Set a timer for 15-30 seconds and begin throwing the snowballs at each other. When the timer stops find the nearest snowball and open it up.
5. Read what the snowball says and do the activity on it.
6. Crumble it back up and repeat steps 4-5.
7. Repeat until all the snowballs have been completed. You can eliminate a snowball each round, if you prefer.

Day 1: Outdoor Activity- Shadow Draw

What you will need:

- 2-3 pieces of paper
- 3-5 toys
- Blocks (optional)
- Writing utensil
- Color pencils/ Markers/ Crayons



Directions

1. Grab a few toys to trace and blocks to put them on to make it sturdy.
2. Set up the toys and make sure the shadow is facing a comfortable spot to trace.
3. Place the piece of paper where the shadow is facing.
4. Trace the outline of the shadow.
5. Once tracing is done, add color to the drawing. Add a background and a signature on the bottom right-hand corner.

Day 1: Indoor Activity- Cloud Play

What you will need:

- Shaving Cream
- Storage bin lid or clean counter

Directions

1. Spray shaving cream on lid or the clean counter top.
2. Mix the shaving cream around and start drawing clouds with your fingertips.
3. Add more shaving cream if it becomes too dry to play in.
